Indian Arm/Port of Vancouver Boating Field Trip

ReThink Class

Thursday May 25th 2017

Dear Parent and or Guardian,

Your son/daughter's ReThink class has an opportunity to go on a field trip by boat around Indian Arm and the Port of Vancouver on Thursday May 25th 2017 to explore the coastal landforms, Port activities, glaciation of the arm, First Nations history, and more. We will be meeting the students at Rocky Point Park in Port Moody at the dock/boardwalk (right beside the Boathouse Restaurant) at 8:30am and will be returning to the same location at 2:30pm. Students will be dismissed from Rocky Point Park when we return at 2:30pm. The cost for this all day boating trip is **\$35.00 per student**. Cheques can be made out to Burnaby North Secondary or you can pay cash or online.

The students are responsible for getting to and from Rocky Point Park. There is a direct bus (Bus 160) from Hastings Street into Port Moody on St. Johns Street that runs every 15 minutes. Students can get off at Murray Street (near Port Moody Elementary School) and walk over the overpass to the park (approximately a 5 minute walk).

The boats are fully licensed and insured with Sea School –through Indian Arm Recreational Services Ltd. and have washrooms on board. Students will need to dress appropriately for the weather and being outside all day. Students also should bring a packed lunch and snacks. We will be stopping in North Vancouver at the Quay for a brief lunch break but bringing a packed lunch is strongly recommended.
