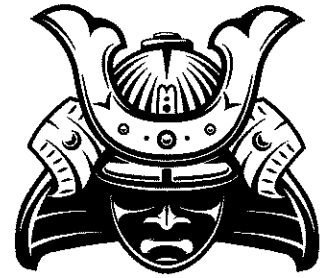


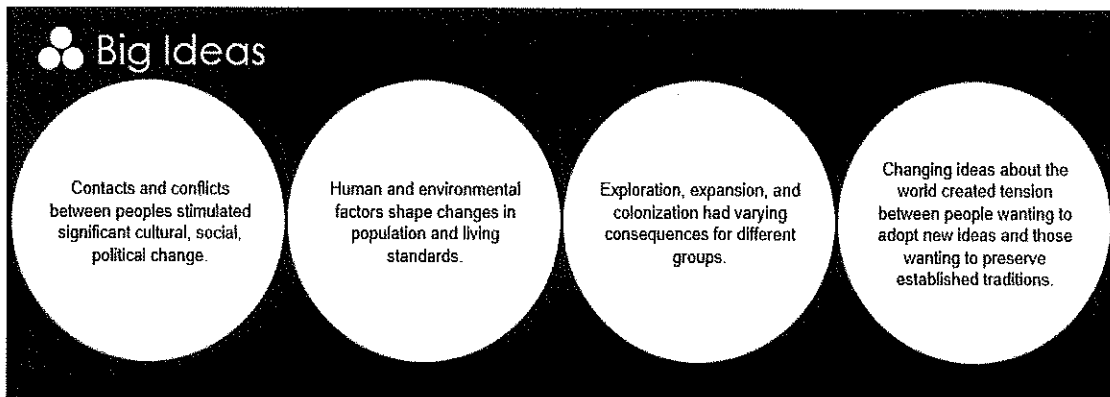

Welcome to Social Studies 8! This socials class reflects the new BC curriculum and includes both the new curricular and core competencies. 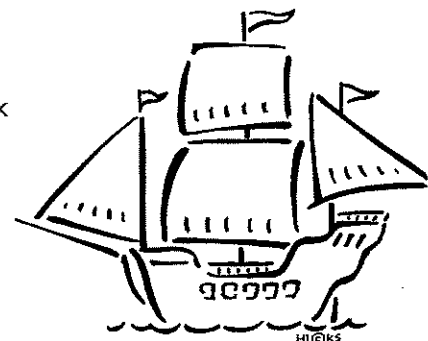


Attendance:

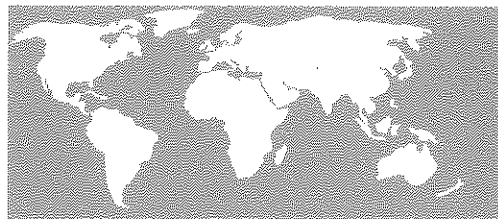
