

REVOLUTION PROJECT



For this project we are going to focus on a Revolution that we have not examined in class yet. You can work alone or in groups of up to 4 people maximum. We have already studied the Industrial Revolution and the American Revolution, so now it is time for you to inquire about another Revolution. You may pick from one of the following:

- The French Revolution
- The Haiti Revolution
- The Russian Revolution
- The Mexican Revolution

What Do You Have to Do?

Once you and your group have picked a revolution, you are to start your research and inquiry into what happened.

- 1) You **MUST** each do your OWN individual research notes and submit them with a proper Bibliography (MLA) style. Minimum of **THREE** sources

- 2) Then you must create a poster about your Revolution that includes:
 - Social Reasons for the Revolution (*problems the people faced, social help, food, care*)
 - Political Reasons for the Revolution (*government problems, rights, Kings/Queens*)
 - Economic Reasons for the Revolution (*\$\$\$, jobs, job problems, money problems*)

- 3) Your poster must also include a title, and images that reflect/show the Revolution, key people, etc.

- 4) On the back of your poster, you will have ONE FINAL PARAGRAPH explaining the main **THEMES** of the Revolution and how these themes (Big Issues) are similar and different to the American Revolution we learned in class.
